



JUAN DIEGO CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL 2019-2020 SCHOOL YEAR FRESHMEN QUALIFYING EXAMS

Mathematics, World Languages: Spanish, Native Spanish and French

In addition to taking the Educational Assessment Exams, incoming freshmen who are interested in enrolling in honors-level courses in mathematics and world languages (Spanish and French) must participate in qualifying exams. Based on the results of the Educational Assessment exams and the Freshmen Qualifying Exams, students will be recommended for their 9th grade courses.

Qualifying exams will be offered for the following subjects:

Mathematics: Please note mathematic exams are not timed; students may complete at their own pace. Math exams may take longer to than one hour to complete.

ENRICHED ALGEBRA I (Honors) and GEOMETRY (Honors): Students must demonstrate mastery of the *Qualifying Arithmetic* exam, and must complete the *Qualifying Elementary Algebra* exam. Based on successful results from both the *Qualifying Arithmetic* and the *Qualifying Elementary Algebra* exams, as well as the Educational Assessment Exams, students may qualify to enroll in either **ENRICHED ALGEBRA I (Honors)** or **GEOMETRY (Honors)**.

ALGEBRA II (Honors): Students must demonstrate mastery of both the *Qualifying Arithmetic* and the *Qualifying Elementary Algebra* exams. In addition, students must complete a Geometry test. Based on successful results on all tests, students may qualify to enroll in **ALGEBRA II (Honors)**.

PRE-CALCULUS (Honors) – Students must demonstrate mastery of Qualifying Arithmetic, Qualifying Algebra and Geometry tests. Based on successful results on all tests, students may qualify to enroll into PRE-CALCULUS (Honors).

World Languages: The qualifying exams for **SPANISH II** and **FRENCH II HONORS** will be the final exam for Spanish I or French I. Students who successfully complete these exams will qualify for the second-year language course. **Students who begin their language career in the second year course must still complete two consecutive years of the same language in grades 9-12 in order to meet graduation requirements.**

SPANISH FOR NATIVE SPEAKERS: Students who are interested in enrolling in Spanish, *whose first language spoken in the home is Spanish, are **REQUIRED** take the Spanish qualifying exam*. This is to ensure these students are not placed in a beginning level Spanish course. If these students are interested in taking French, the Spanish qualifying exam is not necessary.

English, Science & Social Studies: There will be NO Freshmen Qualifying Exams for English, Science and Social Studies. Students will qualify for Honors level courses in English, Science and Social Studies or AP Art History based on their Educational Assessment Exam results.
